Removing a Home Page in Internet Explorer v7

As we discussed last month (tip No. 31), Internet Explorer (IE) v7 allows multiple Home pages to open in individual tabs. The focus of this article is on how to remove a Home page in IE v7.

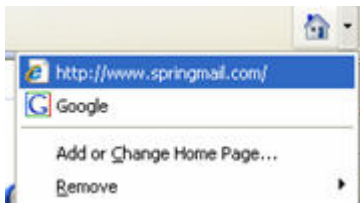
Before we begin, you need to understand that IE v6 handles Home pages differently. Since IE v6 does not allow you to have more than one Home page, all you need to know how to do is change the Home page. Just follow the directions in the article *Change Your Home Page in Internet Explorer - Tip No. 31*, in the section called To set a Home page in IE v6. To remove a Home page in IE v7:

1. Open IE v7.



2. Click on the arrow to the right of the House icon.
3. From the menu, click on **Remove**.



4. In the menu that appears, click on the name of the Home page to be removed.
5. In the Delete Home page dialog box that appears, click the **Yes** button.
6. Close and reopen IE.

To remove all of the Home pages in IE v7:

1. Open IE v7.
2. Click on the arrow to the right of the House icon.
3. From the menu, click on **Remove**.

4. In the menu that appears, click on **Remove All**.
5. In the Delete Home page dialog box that appears, click the **Yes** button.
6. Close and reopen IE.

***Note:** IE must be closed and reopened before the changes take effect.*
